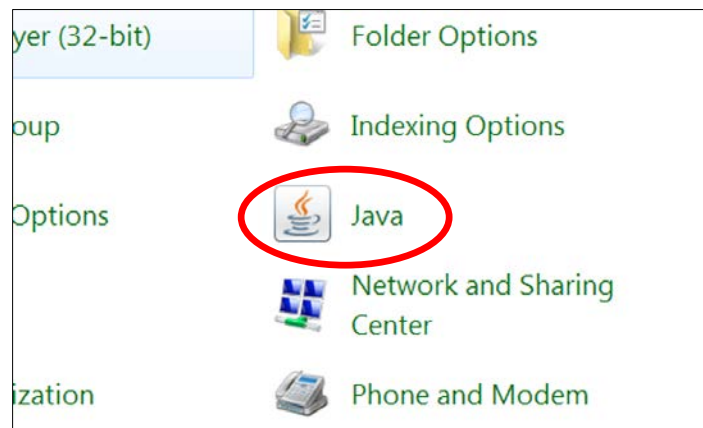
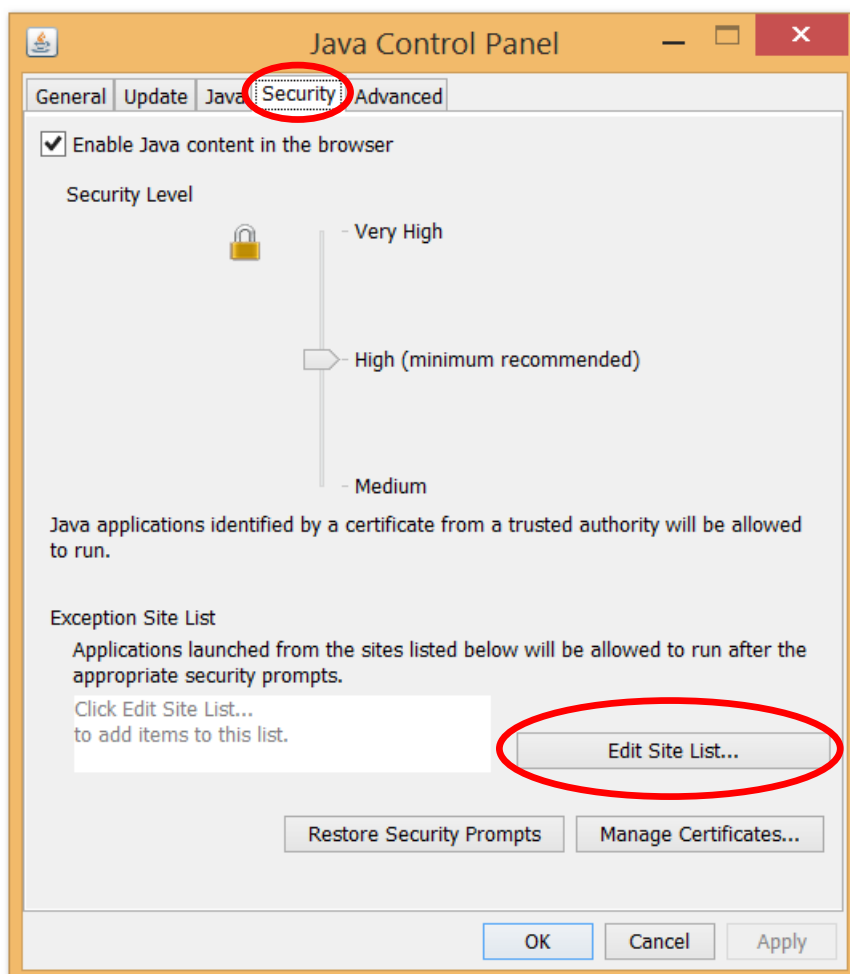


Setting up Doctor Station v.4.0

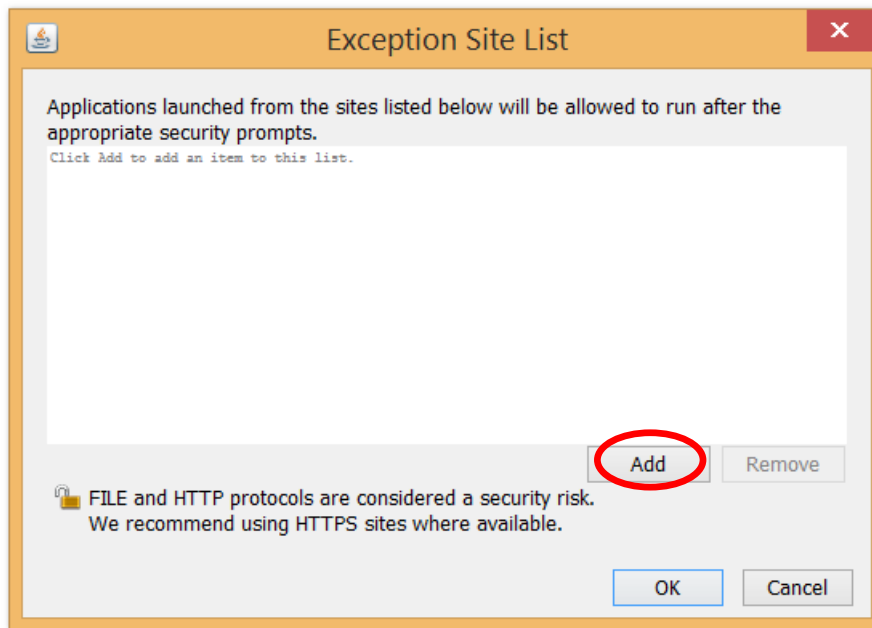
- 1) Download & Install Java (JRE) from <http://www.java.com/en/> (If not already installed).
- 2) Then from control panel, click the Java icon.



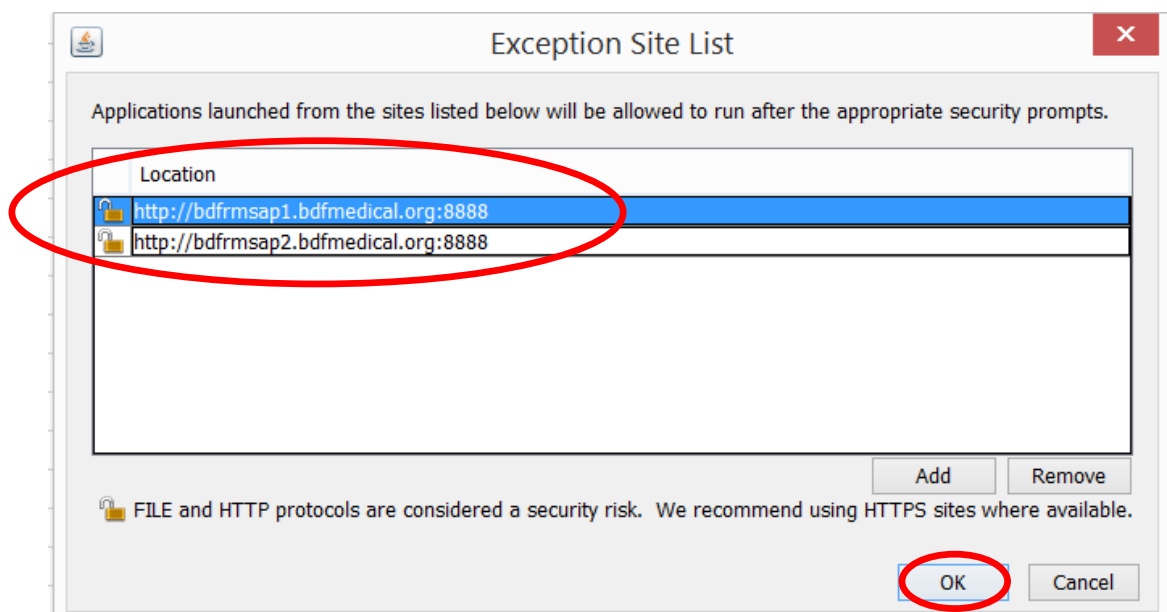
- 3) Click the Security Tab and then click "Edit Site List".



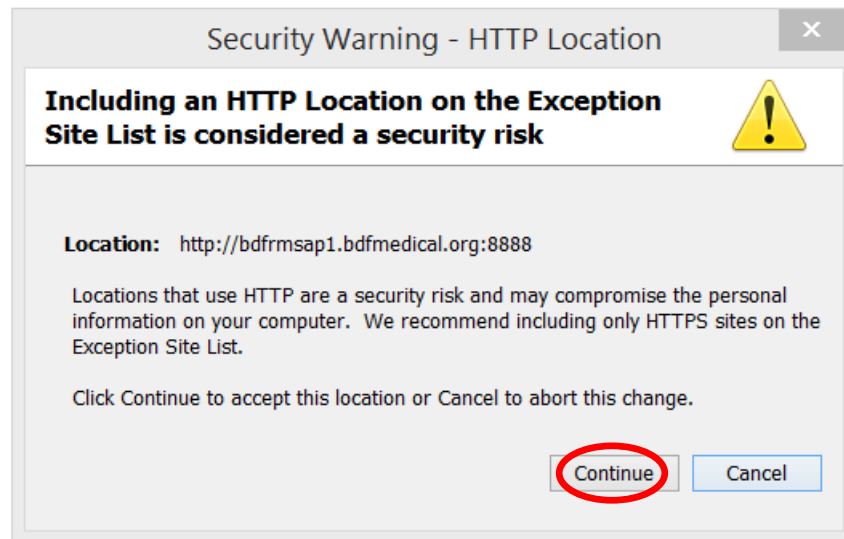
4) Click "Add"



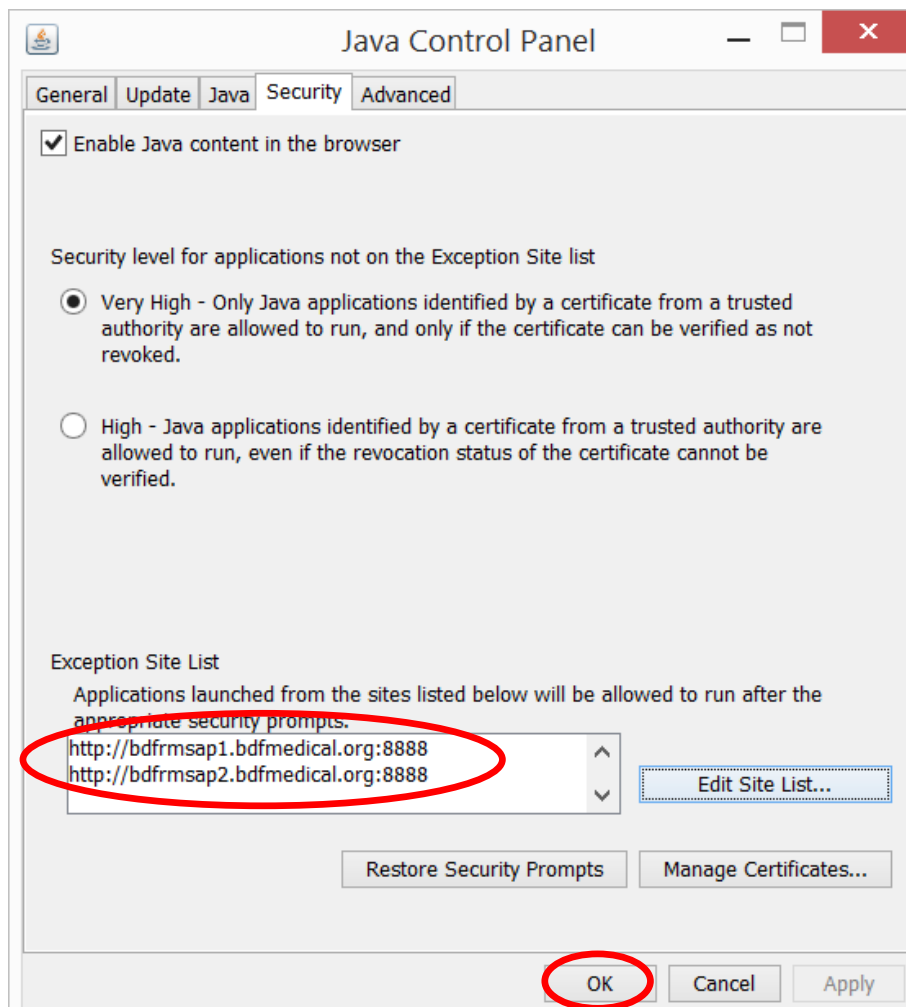
5) Enter the following links one by one , <http://bdfirmsap1.bdfmedical.org:8888> and <http://bdfirmsap2.bdfmedical.org:8888> and then click ok.



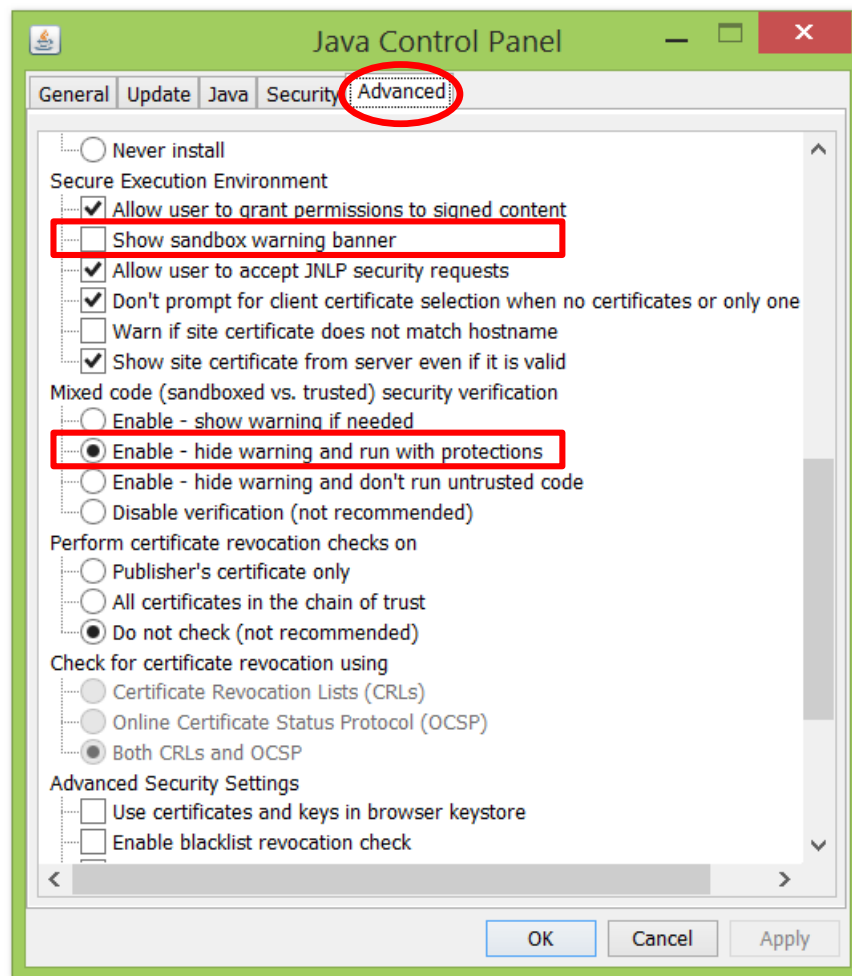
6) Click continue to accept this location.



7) You should see the site on the exception list. Then click Ok.



- 8) Click “Advanced” tab, uncheck “Show sandbox warning banner” and then select the option “Enable – hide warning and run with protections”.



- 9) After installing java, click the link “Doctor Station v.4.0 (new)” and check (acknowledge) all the java messages that appear and click run (this has to be done only once).
- 10) Before the Doctor Station starts a message box will appear requiring user id and password. This user id and password will be provided to authorized users only and is different from the user id and password used to log into the Doctor Station.
